Overview

1. LED Status Indicator
 - Solid blue: Power on and wireless link established.
 - 1 flash/sec.: Pairing Mode.
 - 3 flashes/sec.: During linking.
2. HDMI Connector
3. Pairing Button
4. Mini USB Power Jack



Installation

To Enter Pairing Mode for the Transmitter:


1. Plug the GWHDSTX into the HDMI-ready computer's HDMI port or Source player's HDMI Out.
2. Power is supplied by connecting the Mini USB to USB cable (included in package) to the GWHDSTX and computer with their respective ports. Or connect the power adapter to the Mini USB port on the GWHDSTX and a wall outlet for power supply. The LED Status indicator should light blue when the GWHDSTX is connected to the computer through USB.
3. Press and hold the **Pairing Button**.
4. The GWHDSTX is in Pairing Mode once the Power LED flashes blue slowly. Release the pairing button once it enters Pairing Mode.





To Enter Pairing Mode for the Receiver:

1. Plug in the Power Adapter and connect the receiver to your HDMI display using an HDMI cable (not included in package).



2. Press the **Transmitter No.** key on the remote control, which should be included with your existing receiver.



3. Select **SETUP**; the Setup menu will appear on the on-screen display.



5. Select **Add New Transmitter**.




The on-screen display will show **Searching....**



The Power LED will flash **ORANGE** when it is in Pairing Mode.



To exit Searching mode: Press the **Transmitter No.** key on the remote control.

6. When both the GWHDSTX and Receiver are in Pairing Mode, it will search for each other and automatically pair.



After the pairing is complete, both the GWHDSTX and Receiver will re-boot and establish the link to each other automatically within 5 seconds.

Computer Display Setting

You can adjust your display by going to your computer's screen resolution preferences to choose your HDMI-ready computer setup to be in "Duplicate," "Extend," or "Project Only" for image on the external display.



If all operation is normal, the LED lights on both the transmitter and receiver will be solid blue.
