

Overview

1. USB Type-A Female Port (Output): 5V 2.4A
2. USB Type-C Female Port (Input/Output): 5V 3A
3. LED Charging/Capacity Indicator
4. Battery Capacity Check/On Button



Charging GearPower

Connect the GearPower Mobile Power Station to a power source using the included USB Type-C cable.

1. Plug the USB Type-A connector into the USB port of a 5V 1A ~ 3A power adapter. Plug power adapter into power outlet
2. Insert the USB Type-C connector into the USB Type-C port of the Mobile Power Station.
3. The LED charging indicator will light up "Blue" and blink. Once the Mobile Power Station is fully charged, all four LED charging indicators will light up solid "Blue".

The USB charging cable can be plugged in to your computer's available USB port or any wall-plug style power source.



Charging Mobile Devices

Users need to identify the power supply current they need for their devices. It usually can be found in the mobile device manual.

- USB Type-C (5V 3A) output port supports the latest USB Type-C devices.
- USB Type-A (2.4A) output port is equipped with SmartIQ. It can automatically detect the device connected and supply the correct charging current.

1. Connect the USB Type-A or Type-C connection end of the charging cable to the desired power output port
2. Connect the other end to your mobile device
3. Press the battery ON button. Your device will start charging automatically.

To turn off GearPower, simply long press the battery check button for 2 seconds. To turn on the battery, simply press once.




Product Caring

- Keep Mobile Power Station dry and away from moisture and corrosive materials.
- Do not wash Mobile Power Station
- Re-charge Mobile Power Station once every three months when not in use.

LED Battery Indicator

This chart shows the various stages of power availability and consumption on the Mobile Power Station's LED battery indicator.



*When 1st LED flashes, there is < 20% power.
